- 1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 23rd March, 2011 were confirmed as being a true account.
 - 2.0 **MATTERS ARISING**
 - 2.1 **Bryn Du Football Field** Planning approval was received for the sign for the field. The quote from C Kerry had previously been accepted and he would be requested to proceed to erect the sign.
 - 2.2 **Roadside Hedges** An invoice of £245 was received from J. Pike for trimming back the overgrowth and ivy along the roadside from the cemetery and near the headstones and also for cleaning the cemetery path. It was agreed to pay.
 - 2.3 **Benches** A grant application for the proposed refurbishment of the areas at the bottom of Glan y Mor Road and Shoreside Lay-by had been lodged with the AONB officer. Approx cost for the project is £9000 with a 75% grant if approved. It was agreed for P Gasson to contact 3 contractors to submit quotes for the work. The Clerk had met with the Highways to discuss other proposed sites for benches. There were no objections to the sites near to Boat Island (by the “blue wall”) and Llanfaelog Church. The Clerk would write to Mr & Mrs Unite, Coed y Llan, asking if they had any observations about the former site.
 - 2.4 **Rhosneigr Clock** It was reported that the clock was not chiming. The annual service was due and it would be seen to.
 - 2.5 **Bryn Du Greens** Cllr G Jones was asked to enquire with the relevant department regarding proposed schemes to carry out landscape work on the Glan Gors Terrace and Maes Cynlas greens.
 - 2.6 **Traffic Issues** The Council were informed that the A4080 was to be included in a local speed survey review in 2012.
 - 2.7 **Coed Cwr y Pwll** The Clerk was asked to write to the Highways to request a pathway from the cemetery to the Llanfaelog Woodland gate.
 - 3.0 **LETTERS**
 - 3.1 A renewal notice was received from AON for the insurance for 2011/12. The premium was £4441.30 and it was agreed to pay.
 - 3.2 Notice was received about the review planned by the Boundary Commission for the Anglesey wards for 2012. It was agreed to notify them that the Council were opposed to the idea of multi-member wards.
 - 3.3 Rhosneigr Village Hall requested a nomination from the Council for a representative to sit on the management committee for 2011/12. Cllr Nicholson had indicated to the Clerk that she was willing to be nominated and all agreed to this.
