1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 26th January, 2011 were confirmed as being a true account.

### 2.0 **MATTERS ARISING**

2.1 **Coastal Plan** Minutes of the first meeting of the Steering Group were circulated and discussed. The minutes would be available at the library.

2.2 **Bryn Du Football Field** The design of the sign for the field was approved and would now be submitted for planning approval.

2.3 **Roadside Hedges** The Clerk had been unable to contact G. Morris. The work of cutting back the hedge between the cemetery and the woodland would be offered to J.Pike.

2.4 **Footpaths** The Footpaths Officer was looking into the issues raised at the previous meeting regarding the Lake path and the Bronallt path.

2.5 **Royal Wedding** Arrangements for the village events were publicised and reported to be going well. It was agreed to donate £100 towards the costs, as requested from the organising committee.

2.6 **Play Area** G L Jones had inspected the Rhosneigr School playarea and had identified a few issues that needed rectifying. These would be looked at by the school. It was agreed to pay the invoice of £ 212.40 for the inspection.

2.7 **Benches** A Roberts had quoted £250 to site the two benches along the Maelog Road, clear in front of an existing bench at the picnic area and replace the bench at Broad Beach. It was agreed to accept. It was agreed to approach CCW for permission to drill into the rock at Broad Beach. It was agreed to purchase stainless steel plaques, at £10 each, to place on the sponsored benches. An application was been prepared for AONB funding of 75% for refurbishing the area at the bottom of Glan y Mor Road with new benches and disabled access for which plans would be needed. P Gasson could prepare these at a cost of £473 and it was agreed to proceed.

### 3.0 **LETTERS**

3.1 A communication was received from Cllr Dew updating the situation regarding the Tennis and Bowling Club. Following a meeting that had been with the County Council officers, a suggestion had been put forward to convert the bowling green into a 5 a side football area, which would remove any future replacement costs for the matting. This would be put before the club committee for their views.

3.2 An invoice for £195.22 was received from J Pike for the maintenance of Boat Island, Dec '10- Feb '11. It was agreed to pay. It was noted that her contract ended 31<sup>st</sup> May. Considering the quality of the work over

the past few years, it was agreed to ask J Pike to quote for an extension to the contract for a further 3 years.

- 3.3 A quote for the maintenance of the cemetery borders for 2011 was received from J Pike. It was for the same rate as 2010, £382.50 and it was agreed to accept.
- 3.4 A quote was received from JB Joyce & Co for a replacement cover for one which had recently been blown off the Rhosneigr Clock. It was for £210 +vat. Cllr E A Owen was asked to investigate the work involved in replacing the cover.
- 3.5 A request for financial assistance towards the cemetery maintenance was received from St Maelog's Church. It was agreed to donate £300.
