1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 24th November, 2010 were confirmed as being a true account.

Cllr Gwyneth Parry was welcomed to her first Council meeting

PCSO Sarah Hardie attended the meeting to report on community matters.

### 2.0 MATTERS ARISING

2.1 **Coastal Plan** Following the well attended launch of the Rhosneigr Coastal Infrastructure Masterplan in December a steering group is being formed to look into the proposals within the plan. The group will be made up of representatives of community groups and local business. The Chair, Cllr Morrison, would represent the Community Council on the group.

2.2 **Bryn Du Football Field** The Clerk would contact Chris Kerry for details of the new sign for the entrance in order to obtain planning approval.

2.3 **Roadside Hedges** The hedge between the cemetery and the woodland needed cutting back. The Clerk would contact G. Morris to carry out the work.

2.4 **Dog Fouling** It would be reported to Cllr G Jones that a dog bin was needed by the telephone kiosk in Bryn Du.

2.5 **Footpaths** Some issues were raised about the path from Bronallt towards the Lake. These would be reported to the Footpaths Officer.

2.6 **County Council Meeting** Cllr Morrison and Cllr Barlow had attended a meeting in Llangefni between the County Council and Community Council's to discuss the budget and future communication issues between the Councils. Consultation papers regarding the budget were also received and were briefly summarised by Cllr Dew.

2.7 **Speed Survey** The A4080 within the community had been monitored and speed of cars was not found to be excessive at the time.

2.8 **Royal Wedding** Cllr Morrison was representing the Council on the committee formed to arrange local wedding celebrations.

### 3.0 LETTERS

3.1 Request received from the County Council for the Community Council Precept 2011/12. It was agreed to increase it by £500 to £18,800.

3.2 Notification received for planned future courses for the Code of Conduct. Agreed to participate.

- 3.3 Consultation letter received from the County Council for the proposal of charges being placed on the Library car park. Further information would be requested regarding the financial benefit of this. Shortage of parking space in Rhosneigr would also be noted.
- 3.4 Water invoices received. Cemetery - £25.81. Football field - £16.33. Agreed to pay.
- 3.5 Requests for financial assistance were received and it was agreed to the following donations:  
Llanfaelog Youth Club - £400. Rhosneigr Brownies - £300. Rhosneigr School, Football Goals - £250  
Rhosneigr Boys Institute ( Cllr EA Owen declared interest and left the room) - £700. Marie Curie - £50
- 3.6 Rhosneigr Library requested a donation towards a display cabinet. It was agreed that the Community Council would purchase a cabinet for £825 + vat and loan it to the Library.
- 3.7 Confirmation was received from Rhosneigr School that the new play area, once completed, would be available for public use outside school hours and that it would be covered by the school's insurance. Before a new play surface was purchased, it was agreed that the Community Council would pay £177 + vat for an inspection by GL Jones of the apparatus.

Would apply for AONB grant to finance. Proposed new bench adjacent telephone kiosk in Llanfaelog and picnic benches in Llanfaelog woodland, subject to Woodland Trust permission – Cllr D Owen to approach. The Clerk would ask Prosperity Recycling for quotes for new benches.

7.3 Cllr Dew was asked to report to the Highways that the edge of the roadway between the Rhosneigr Station and the Golf Club was in need of repair.
