1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2011 were confirmed as being a true account.

### 2.0 **MATTERS ARISING**

2.1 **Benches** 3 quotes were received by Mr P. Gasson for the refurbishment of the seating areas at Glan y Mor Road and Shoreside Lay-By. On his recommendation, it was agreed, on condition of been awarded the AONB grant, to accept the quote of H. Hughes which was for £7765.17 + vat. Mr A. Roberts would be asked to quote for concrete bases for the new benches by Llanfaelog Church and existing bench at the picnic area.

2.2 **Bryn Du Greens** Application forms and plans were given to Cllr D Jones

2.3 **Coed Cwr y Pwll** Funding for the proposed path from the woodland towards Pencarnisiog would be applied for from the Safer Routes in Community fund. This would need to be applied for by a community group and the appropriate forms were given to Cllr I Edwards.

2.4 **Llanfaelog Village Hall** 2 quotes for the refurbishment of the chimney were received and it was agreed to accept the one from Kenwyn Builders for £580.

3.1 A letter was received from the County Council stating that a review panel was looking into the future of the Island's public toilets and asking for the Council's views on various proposals. It was agreed that the toilets in the Rhosneigr Car Park were vital for local tourism and should continue to be run by the County Council.

3.2 Communication received from the Welsh Government stating that the review of the Island's electoral arrangements did not affect the Community Council boundaries.

3.3 A questionnaire was received from One Voice Wales re the Community Council's liaison with young people.

3.4 Notification received from the Footpaths Officer that a seating stone was to be placed by the Llyn Maelog footpath following a request from a local resident.

3.5 Notificaton received that a request had been received by the Highways Dept for the Rhosneigr High Street to be closed on 27<sup>th</sup> August as part of the Rhosneigr Festival.
