

Llanfaelog Community Council

Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 23rd March, 2011 at 7.00 at the Llanfaelog Village Hall.

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- 1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 23rd February, 2011 were confirmed as being a true account.
 - 2.0 **MATTERS ARISING**
 - 2.1 **Bryn Du Football Field** A planning application for the sign for the field had been lodged and a fee of £45.50 paid.
 - 2.2 **Roadside Hedges** A quote was received from J. Pike to trim back the overgrowth and ivy along the roadside from the cemetery and also to clean the cemetery path and overgrowing hedge near the headstones. It was £245 and was accepted by the Council.
 - 2.3 **Benches** An invoice for £230 was received from A Roberts for placing the two benches along the Maelog Road, clear in front of an existing bench at the picnic area and replace the bench at Broad Beach. It was agreed to pay. It was agreed to pay an invoice of £123 from Mona F&T for 10 stainless steel plaques to place on sponsored benches. Plans prepared by P Gasson for the proposed refurbishment of the area at the bottom of Glan y Mor Road were viewed and approved.
 - 2.4 **Boat Island** It was agreed to accept a quote from J Pike for the maintenance of Boat Island for 3 years, from 1st June 2011 to 31st May 2014, at £786/year.
 - 2.5 **Rhosneigr Clock** It was agreed to order a replacement plastic cover for the one missing off one clock face.
 - 2.6 **Llanfaelog Village Hall** It was reported that Hogans, through Cllr W Williams, had supplied 10 tons of gravel free of charge for the hall's car park. C Jones had levelled it and tidied around the edges. A letter of thanks had been sent to Hogans. An invoice of £600 had been received from A Owen for painting the hall's windows and was paid as previously agreed.
 - 2.7 **Traffic Issues** Further to enquiries with the Highways Dept: The road from Rehoboth towards Rhosneigr Station is too narrow for a footway. No funding is available for a crossing point in Llanfaelog. The land outside the "Blue wall" near Boat Island belongs to the Council and it would be possible to place a bench at the site.

 - 3.1 An invoice for £70 was received from A Roberts for repairs to the Rhosneigr Clock bus shelter. It was agreed to pay.
 - 3.2 An invoice for £840 was received, and as previously agreed, paid to Access Display for a display cabinet for the Library.
 - 3.3 Notice was received for a training session on 10th May for the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

- 3.4 Renewal of membership of One Voice Wales 2011/12 was agreed at a cost of £300.
- 3.5 Notification received that the new telephone number for the GP Out of Hours Service had now changed to 0300 123 55 66
