Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 25th May, 2011 at 7.00 at the Llanfaelog Village Hall.

Due to the unavoidable absence of the Chair and Vice Chair, Cllr EA Owen stood in as Chairman.

Maritime Officers, Duncan Brown and John Owen, attended the meeting together with a representative of the RBA. Matters discussed were the trialling this year of the option of launching through Boat Pool at high tide and the parking of some trailers under Boat Pool outlook. The laying of a temporary trackway at the beach entrance to Boat Pool was been investigated for 2012. It was reported that sand buggies are used on Cymyran beach which is permitted. It was also pointed out the large number of dogs on the beaches and it was suggested that restrictions on these be put in the by-laws for some beaches during the summer.

1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2011 were confirmed as being a true account.

### 2.0 **MATTERS ARISING**

2.1 **Benches** An objection was received from Mr & Mrs Unite, Coed y Llan, regarding the placement of a bench outside their property. It was therefore agreed not to proceed. It was decided that the spare bench would be used to replace the one opposite the telephone kiosk in Llanfaelog. A quote for benches and picnic benches was received from Prosperity Recycling and it was agreed to order.

2.2 **Bryn Du Greens** Cllr G Jones had requested the appropriate application forms and stated that plans were now required for the schemes.

2.3 **Coed Cwr y Pwll** The Clerk informed the Council that the request for a pathway from the cemetery to the Llanfaelog Woodland gate had been granted and the work would be carried out at the end of the summer. A petition for the footway to be extended to Pencarnisiog was handed to Cllr G Jones and he would be meeting with the Highways to discuss this request.

2.4 **Llanfaelog Village Hall** One quote for the repair work to the hall's chimney had been received with another awaited. The quote was not opened and it was agreed to wait another 2 weeks. After this time it was agreed that the Chair and Clerk would meet to award the contract.

### **ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR FOR 2011/12**

Cllr E A Owen was proposed and seconded for position of Chair as was Cllr J Morrison. Following a vote, Cllr E A Owen was elected. He however declined the post and therefore Cllr J Morrison was elected Chair.

Cllr I Edwards was elected Vice-Chair.

Following the election, PC Howell Owens and PCSO Sarah Hardie attended the meeting to report on local issues. Amongst matters discussed were cars speeding along Ffordd y Wylan and large number of youths coming into Rhosneigr by train at weekends. These would be monitored.
