Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 23rd January 2013 at 7pm at Llanfaelog Village Hall.

- 1.0 Apologies: Cllrs: Rod Thackray, Helen Nicholson, Cllr Glyn Jones,
- 2.0 The minutes of the meeting held 28th November 2012 were confirmed as being a true account.
- 3.0 Matters Arising.
 - 3.1 Affordable Housing Scheme. The Council was supportive and encouraged residents to take part in the forthcoming housing needs survey.
 - 3.2 Rhosneigr Clock. The clock was showing incorrect time – Cllr Dew had already contacted Smith of Derby and would pursue the replacement of the clock lights and two plastic covers.
 - 3.3 Sue Shoesmith has started her boot camp at Bryn Du Football Field.
 - 3.4 The Clerk had contacted G.L. Jones to replace the bolts and bushes at Rhosneigr Playfield at the cost of £994.68 plus VAT
 - 3.5 Cllr Morrison was thanked for supervising work at Broad Beach by Chris Jones.
 - 3.6 The sum of £52 was payable to H. R. Hughes and Son to cover VAT – agreed to pay.

 - 4.1 County Council request for the Community Council to set its precept for 2013/14 – agreed a £700 increase to £20,000.
 - 4.2 Draft lease received from Anglesey Council for the Rhosneigr Play Area – agreed to send it back requesting amendments.
 - 4.3 Letter from Anglesey Council stating there was no funding available to build a safe path at Rehoboth and a Pelican crossing this financial year.

- 4.4 An invitation from Anglesey Council to attend a liaison evening on January 29th re budgets – Cllr Barlow and Clerk to attend.
- 4.5 A letter from Anglesey Council Highways Dept re consultation on Flood Management Act 2010 – Cllr Barlow to study document.

- 4.7 Letter received from Môn Grass Cutting offering a free estimate – resolved to invite four grass cutting services to submit tenders for grass cutting at Llanfaelog Cemetry by February 20th. First cut around mid March, last cut October, maximum 16 cuts. A cost per cut was required.
