1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2011 were confirmed as being a true account.

## 2.0 MATTERS ARISING

2.1 **Bryn Du Football Field** The Clerk and Cllr I Edwards had received complaints regarding the untidiness of the field and changing rooms following their use by Gwalch FC. This had been brought to the attention of the team's management. Since the complaints had continued it was agreed that the Clerk write to Gwalch FC pointing out the terms of the lease which required the facility be kept tidy at all times.

2.2 **Project Rhosneigr** Communication had been received informing the Council that on 26<sup>th</sup> November the Christmas Lights would be switched on and requesting permission to once again place lights on the Clock. It was agreed to permit. Following the success of this year's August Festival, it was also agreed to pledge £500 towards the cost of staging the event in 2012.

2.3 **Minstrel Lodge Site** Following a request from the Highways Dept it was suggested that the development should be named "Y Bonc" as this was the site's original name.

2.4 **Royal British Legion** It was agreed to donate £80 to the RBL for the remembrance wreaths for the Rhosneigr and Bryn Du memorials.

3.1 Notification was received from the external auditors that the accounts 2010/11 had been accepted with no issues raised. Following Council's approval these would be returned for the issue of a Notice of Conclusion.

3.2 A note was received from Mr Michael Kennan complimenting the work done on Boat Pool outlook.

3.3 Notice was received from the County Council that general litter bins could be

used for depositing dog waste.

- 3.7 A draft lease for the tenancy of the Tennis and Bowling Club had been received. There were items within which needed clarifying before acceptance. The comments of the club's management committee on the lease would be requested.
