1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2012 were confirmed as being a true account.

### 2.0 **MATTERS ARISING**

2.1 **Rhosneigr Clock** An engineer from Smith of Derby had inspected the clock prior to the electrifying work and had reported that 3 fused electric outlets were required to be fitted. Cllr E Owen would ask an electrician to carry out the work asap.

2.2 **Coed Cwr y Pwll** Cllr Morrison and the Clerk had met with the Woodland Trust and Menter Mon regarding the lease and the grant application. Woodland Trust favoured more community involvement with the woodland's management. It was agreed to look at setting up a volunteer group and notices advertising this would be put up in order to gauge local opinion. In the meantime, Menter Mon agreed to fund the architect fees for drawing up plans for the proposed car park.

2.3 **Llyn Maelog** The Clerk reported that following a meeting he had with the engineer from the Environment Agency, there was no funding available for EA to divert the outflow from Llyn Maelog at Broad Beach at the present time.

2.4 **Footpaths** An invoice for £400 was received from GW Morris for cutting the overgrown path at Bryn Du Isaf. It was agreed to pay.

### **ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR FOR 2012/13**

Cllr E A Owen was proposed and seconded for position of Chair and was elected.

Cllr D Barlow was elected Vice-Chair.

### 3.0 **LETTERS**

3.1 A letter of resignation was received from the Clerk. It was decided to advertise the post with the ability to communicate in Welsh as desirable. The closing date for applications was set as mid-July.

3.2 The issue of parking along the Rhosneigr High Street was discussed and a site meeting would be arranged with the County Council's Parking Officer to look into the matter.

3.3 A further "Review of the Electoral Arrangements for Anglesey" was received following earlier consultations. It is proposed to amalgamate Llanfaelog, Rhosneigr, Llanfair yn Neubwll and Valley and to have 2 councillors representing the ward. The name Llifon was proposed for the ward. The Council suggested the name Cymyran for the proposed ward and this would be communicated to the boundary commission.

3.4 An invoice for the Football Field electricity was received from EON. It was for £8.69 and was agreed to pay

3.5 A report on the play areas was received from GL Jones. All the apparatus was in need of painting and bolts needed to be replaced. As the council are looking at refurbishing the area in Bryn Du and discussing the Rhosneigr area with the school, the work would be considered once quotes were received. It was agreed to pay GL Jones' invoice for £318.60

3.6 A request for sponsorship was received from Miss Sophie Lewis, an athlete from Bryn Du, who hoped to qualify for the 2013 Island Games in Bermuda. It was agreed that if she qualified, the Council would sponsor her with £100.
