Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 27th July, 2011 at 7.00 at the Llanfaelog Village Hall.

1.0 The minutes of the meeting held on the 22nd June, 2011 were confirmed as being a true account.

### 2.0 **MATTERS ARISING**

2.1 **Benches** It was agreed to accept the quote of £100 from Mr A. Roberts for concrete bases for the new benches by Llanfaelog Church. The order for the new benches would be submitted.

2.2 **Bryn Du Greens** Agreed to put scheme on hold and to develop the area at the football field behind the cabins with the addition of junior size goal posts instead. Mona F&T would be asked to quote for 12'x6' goalposts.

2.3 **Coed Cwr y Pwll** It was reported that the roadside verge from the woodland towards the Bryn Du junction was in need of cutting back. Cllr G Jones would enquire.

2.4 **Llanfaelog Village Hall** The cost from Kenwyn Builders for the refurbishment of the chimney had increased to £1540 due to the need for

additional scaffolding. This had been passed by the Chair and it was agreed to pay.

2.5 **Bryn Du Cemetery** The Clerk had informed the Chapel that they would be reimbursed the cost of grasscutting at the cemetery after completion of the work.

2.6 **Picnic Area** It was agreed to order a “No Camping” sign for the area from C Kerry at a cost of £57.50 + vat

### 3.0 **LETTERS**

3.1 An invoice for £612 was received from RPG Ltd for grass cutting at the football field. It was agreed to pay.

3.2 An invoice for £5.03 was received from E.ON, electricity supply at football field. It was agreed to pay.

3.3 An invoice for £127.50 was received from J Pike for the maintenance of the cemetery borders. It was agreed to pay.

3.4 Water invoices were received: Cemetery supply, £19.55. Football field, £12.93. It was agreed to pay.

3.5 Information was received from the County Council regarding the strengthening of communication between County and Community councils. It was proposed to hold a meeting to discuss this at the end of September.

3.6 Communication received from County Council recommending that the Community Council adopt a system of using “Declaration of Interest” forms at future meetings. It was agreed to adopt this as from September 2011.

- 3.7 Consultation received regarding the joint Anglesey and Gwynedd Local Development plan. Following on from this, it was decided to write to the Economic Development Department commenting on the lack of progress following the Coastal Masterplan report.

Cllr G Jones left the meeting.

- 3.8 Following concerns about bulls in fields crossed by footpaths, a letter was received from the Footpaths officer confirming that it was in order as long as the bull was not of a dairy breed and was with other cattle.

- 3.9 A request for financial assistance received from “Y Rhwyd” community paper. It was agreed to donate £50.

- 3.10 An enquiry was received regarding the purchase of plots in the cemetery. Plots are sold to undertakers as needed and as there are sufficient plots at present it was agreed not to sell individually unless there were exceptional circumstances.
